The boys of summer are back in April starts the America's pastime. Little known fact, Mickey Mantle was a member of the New York City Elks Lodge #1 along with Babe Ruth. Lodge #1 has an area of memorabilia. Be a great place to visit.

Just for your own FYI, ever wonder why baseballs are

switched out whenever they hit the dirt? Typical game uses 60 baseballs. Well, back on August 16, 1920, the Yankees were playing a team that would become Cleveland Indians. Carl Mays threw a heater to Ray Chapman which struck Chapman in the head. The sound so loud Mays thought it hit the bat. Mays fielded the ball and threw to first base. Chapman was by then sprawled out on the ground with a wound to his head. He was taken to the hospital where he died 12 hours later. Rules were set in place to instruct umpires to replace any ball that hits the dirt. The spitball was also disallowed. The use of batting helmets were not mandatory until 30 years later. With the death of a spectator in 2019, the net behind the batter is now extended to the foul pole.
