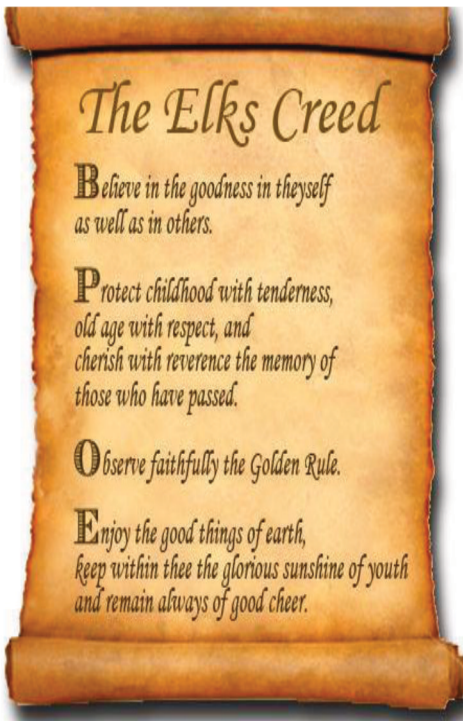
keep it working.

You never know whose watching. The Officers of our Lodge and every other Lodge perform an Initiation Ritual every month for new members to make an impression upon them. This has been going on for 151 years. I've

mentioned in earlier columns how President Woodrow Wilson, in 1916, witnessed the Elks Flag Day Ritual. President Wilson was so inspired he went to Congress and proclaimed June 14th as Flag Day. The Elks have been doing this Ritual since 1908, when it was performed at the Grand Lodge Convention in Dallas, Texas. Let's give thanks to our Brother Elks who created this ritual, James Kind of Topeka, Kansas, Charles Lahan of Chicago and William Hargest of Harrisberg, Pennsylvania (hope you're taking notes).

Our Eleven O'clock toast meant so much to General John Pershing that, when President Wilson gave him the authority to choose the day and time of the WWI armistice, Pershing chose the 11th hour on the 11th day and on the 11th month as a tribute to his roots in Elkdom.

Now, I was really blown away while watching an old Andy Griffith rerun, called "Hot Rod Otis". It aired February 17th, 1964. If you remember the character of Otis, he was the town drunk. Well, he buys a 1933 Ford and Barney and Andy have to keep a watch on him. They get him in their cell and, to trick him into thinking he had died in a car accident, they sing the song "The Vacant Chair" which we sing at our meetings when we learn of a departed member. It was the only episode that Barney sang *on key*.

Returning GI's that needed a hand in getting back into civilian life were assisted when the Elks gave out loans in the amount of \$40,000 until the government got on board and created the "GI Bill".

So, many rituals that the Elks have are so meaningful. It was at the Grand lodge Convention in 1890 that the Elks declared, *the first Sunday in December of each year is hereby designated and dedicated as a day on which shall be commemorated by every Lodge of Elks, the Memorial of our departed brothers and shall be known as Elks Memorial Day.* You don't need to have lost someone to attend. It is support for those who have and to maintain that Elks are never forgotten, never forsaken. Put it on your 2020 calendar.

Some may not be aware, but in the Ritual there is provision for a Past Exalted Rulers' Night. On the first Lodge meeting in February the Exalted Ruler can appoint Past Exalted Rulers to fill the four chair positions as well as Esquire and Chaplain. This is a good opportunity to give special recognition to those who have served in the highest office in their Lodge over the years and keep them involved in the life of your Lodge. In some cases Past Exalted Rulers are called on to conduct an initiation, which would be a special treat that generates interest among the membership.

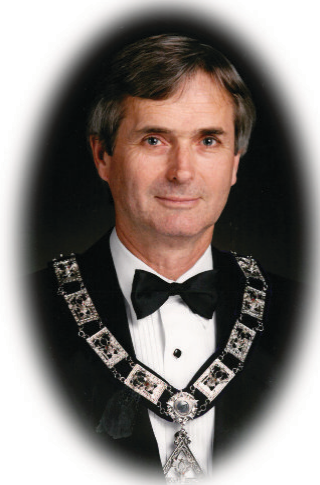

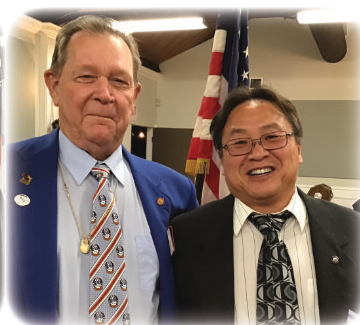

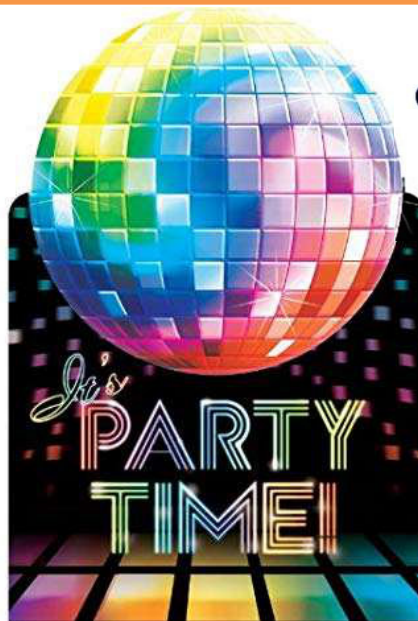
