under the California plan to reopen, the hurdles to operating are significant, ranging from operating at 25% capacity, maintaining social distancing, wearing masks, requiring member screening and sign-in, constant sanitizing, and serving a beverage only on the same ticket as food. The Health Department has advised us that we may not serve from the kitchen window

"When are we going to in the hallway between the bar and the anteroom, so we will have to provide food service from the bar. These are just a few of the issues and we will require paid staff and volunteers to cover the service, cleaning, setup and monitoring. And while Ventura County hopefully may be moving up to the "orange zone" shortly, there will still be similar restrictions in place with an increase in permitted patrons to 50% of capacity, up from the present 25%. Given our facility size and layout, this increase will not significantly improve our situation. Nevertheless, we expect to review plans to expand present service levels in the very near future and we are continuing our Grab & Go meals and Saturday BBQ.

> A different answer to the question "when are we opening up" is that the lodge is

open. I say this because our charity and community service activities continue thanks to the efforts of your officers, committee chairs and volunteers. We are planning our Christmas tree lot project, flag retirement, Christmas basket program, on-site Covid-19 testing and blood drive. All of these lodge activities require volunteers, so please help us continue the good works we do. Remember: WE ARE A LODGE WITH A BAR, NOT A BAR WITH A LODGE. So please help us continue to keep the lodge open by volunteering to help with these activities.
