Interesting Tidbit!

Our founder **Charles Vivian** (who never actually became an Elk, story for another Antler Antics) was on the road entertaining in opera houses across the USA. After arriving in Leadville, Colorado, Charles passed away from pneumonia in 1880 at age 34. The town of Leadville held a benefit for his funeral expenses. His service was held at the Tabor Opera House, a fitting tribute to a man who'd lived half his life on stage. The Leadville newspaper wrote of Vivian "a man of many friends whose kind nature and genial manners drew toward him, and many a tear has shed. He has no successor in either stage or social circles."

In 1889, nine years after his death, Elks Lodge #10 in Boston, Massachusetts, raised funds for a monument to **Charles Vivian** and paid for his body transport to its new home at Mt. Hope Cemetery in Boston.


