LEVELS OF COMPETITION

Youth ages 8-13 are invited to compete in three age groups, 8-9, 10-11, and 12-13, with girls and boys competing separately. Participants can only compete at **ONE** Lodge contest per year. Then, they must compete—and win—at each level along the way before stamping a ticket to the National Finals.

PRELIMINARY



At the Lodge Director's discretion, in some communities, the season kicks off with a community-hosted contest. Winners advance to the Lodge contest.

LODGE



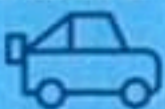
The official entry in the contest. Competitors are allowed to participate in **ONE** Lodge contest a season.

DISTRICT*



Six Lodge winners advance to compete with other participants from nearby Lodge communities. *Several states do not hold District contests.

STATE



District* winners travel and meet other participants from their home state. *Several states do not hold District contests.

REGIONAL



State winners hit the road again as Regional Semi-Finalists—competing against winners from multiple states.

FINALS



Regional winners become the 72 National Finalists who compete on the national stage in April in Chicago. Six Finalists become National Champions and are commemorated in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame!
