LEVELS OF COMPETITION

Youth ages 8-13 are invited to compete in three age groups, 8-9, 10-11, and 12-13, with girls and boys competing separately. Participants can only compete at **ONE** Lodge contest per year. Then, they must compete—and win—at each level along the way before stamping a ticket to the National Finals.

PRELIMINARY	At the Lodge Director's discretion, in some communities, the season kicks off with a community-hosted contest. Winners advance to the Lodge contest.
LODGE	The official entry in the contest. Competitors are allowed to participate in ONE Lodge contest a season.
DISTRICT*	Six Lodge winners advance to compete with other participants from nearby Lodge communities. *Several states do not hold District contests.
STATE	District* winners travel and meet other participants from their home state. *Several states do not hold District contests.
REGIONAL	State winners hit the road again as Regional Semi-Finalists—competing against winners from multiple states.
FINALS	Regional winners become the 72 National Finalists who compete on the national stage in April in Chicago. Six Finalists
